## CARE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE YEAR AWARD

The award will be presented to a Day Care Unit or Residential Care Establishment whose service of meals delivers choice, meets dietary needs and ensures that the eating environment and standards provided improve the eating experience throughout the day. The judges will evaluate within the submission evidence of:

- Outstanding levels of service
- Having demonstrated all clients have choices, respect and dignity within the establishment
- Person-centred planning

To nominate you need to submit a summary of no more than 1,000 words together with supporting evidence to demonstrate that management systems are in place and evidence to support nutritional screening, hydration and other initiatives. Submissions should be sent to the NACC Admin Office with your contact details by Friday 28th June 2013.

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## COMMUNITY MEALS AWARD

The award is presented to the authority, business or individual who has demonstrated the most effective policy for Community Meals raising the profile of the meals service whilst adding value to the service. The judges will evaluate within the submission evidence of:

- Marketing & promotion of the meals service
- Meeting NACC standards
- Improved customer experience
- Has added value i.e. Fire Checks, Hydration, Nutritional Screening

To nominate someone for this award please send all marketing material, press cuttings, photos etc. plus a brief description of the activities that took place during the year. Submissions should be sent to the NACC Admin Office with your contact details by Friday 28th June 2013.

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## CATERING TEAM OR INDIVIDUAL AWARD

The award will be presented to the team or individual who has demonstrated outstanding achievement in their field. They will have displayed provision of well balanced nutritious menus and empowered customers. The judges will evaluate:

- Implementation of the 10 key Characteristics of Good Nutritional Care
- Evidence of customer consultation
- Creativity and effectiveness
- Added value to the service

To nominate someone for this award please send all marketing material, press cuttings, photos etc. plus a brief description of the activities that took place during the year. Submissions should be sent to the NACC Admin Office with your contact details by Friday 28th June 2013.

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## INNOVATION OR ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The award will be presented to a region, individual, company or group who have made a significant contribution over the year to the NACC and have displayed outstanding innovation in products, service development or procedures. It will encompass initial success and on going potential. The judging panel will evaluate:

- Added value to the industry
- Demonstration of outstanding leadership
- Links to NACC policies and documentation

To nominate you need to write a brief summary in no more than 1,000 words, which will demonstrate why the nomination is worthy of this recognition. Submissions should be sent to the NACC Admin Office with your contact details by Friday 28th June 2013.

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## SUSTAINABILITY AWARD

The award recognises the efforts of a company, care establishment or provider to procure both food and equipment ethically. They must show a continuing commitment to a programme of improved sustainability in their policies. Evidence can be collected from certification in Higher Animal Welfare, sustainable fish, seasonal menus and fuel efficiencies in equipment purchase. The judging panel will evaluate:

- If the nominee is effectively engaged in sustainable procurement and food sourcing
- If criteria is in place for sourcing energy efficient and environmentally preferable equipment
- If the nominee is developing, or has plans in place, to minimise food miles

To nominate you need to write a brief summary in no more than 1,000 words, which will demonstrate why the nomination is worthy of this recognition. Submissions should be sent to the NACC Admin Office with your contact details by Friday 28th June 2013.

## HYDRATION AWARD

The award will be presented to an individual, group or company who during the year has made a significant contribution to best practice in hydration, using National Indicators and guidelines, thereby improving the residents' and service users' quality of life. The judging panel will evaluate:

- Current and former practices
- Menu development
- Development of strategies
- Screening tool usage
- Initiatives
- Evidence of improvements
- Hydration practices

To nominate you will need to submit a summary of no more than 1,000 words together with supporting evidence to demonstrate that management systems are in place and evidence to support nutritional screening, hydration and other initiatives. Submissions should be sent to the NACC Admin Office with your contact details by Friday 28th June 2013.

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## REGIONAL AWARD

Nominations for this award need to be submitted by the regional committee and need to demonstrate the successful operation of the region throughout the year. The award will be presented to the region that most effectively meets the judging criteria. The judging panel will evaluate:

- How the region has raised the profile of the NACC
- Added value to members
- Originality of ideas
- Meeting level attendance (based on % levels)
- Leadership of the regional committee
- Maintenance of funds

To nominate, the Regional Chairman should submit no more than 250 words outlining the Region's activities since April 2012 and support it with the photographic evidence, documents or other relevant information. Submissions should be sent to the NACC Admin Office with your contact details by Friday 28th June 2013.

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## PAM RHODES OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT AWARD
